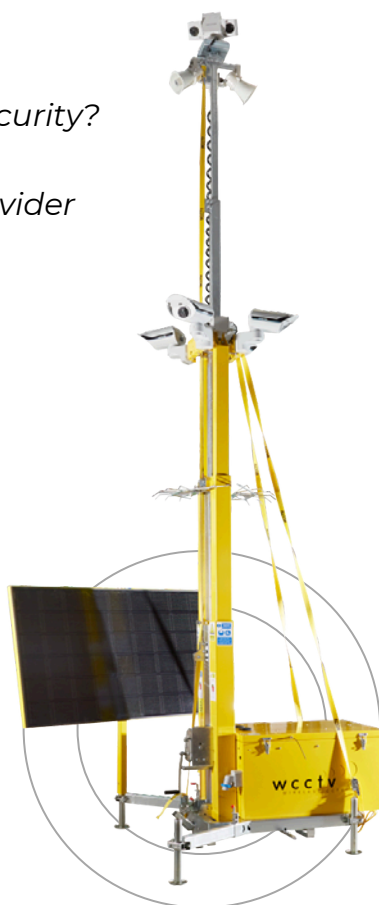

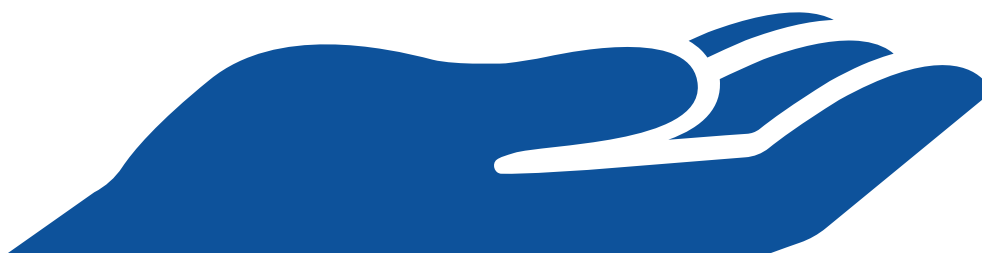

Cost-Effective

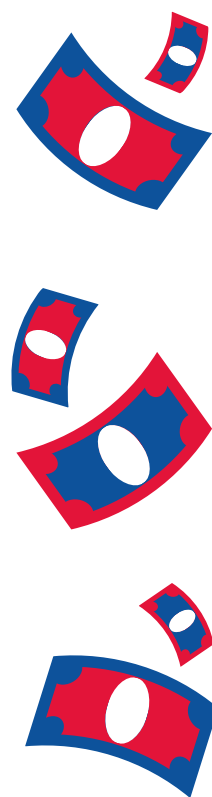
Choosing the cheapest security option is unlikely to produce the expected results with your security, however, choosing the most expensive option does not necessarily guarantee you the best service either.

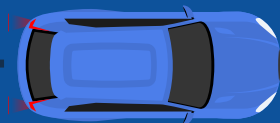
Fixed, traditional surveillance systems cannot be moved easily, if at all and even with some mobile CCTV solutions, relocation can be difficult and require additional assistance.
